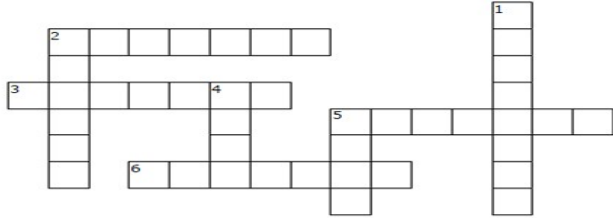


Christ the King
