### THREE WORDS: same idea.

1. **“LITURGY”** comes from the Greek word, “LEITOURGIA?” meaning “the work of the People”
2. **“WORSHIP”** comes from the word “WEORTHSCIBE” literally “WORTHY + SHIP” meaning ascribing worth or respect. Worship is the response of a people to a faithful God. Worship includes our service to others.
3. **“SERVICE”** - work offered or done. We sometimes use the word service in place of the word worship. The Christian life is a Liturgical life, a worshipping life and a life of service. Service to God and service to mankind. Summed up in the commandments— “Love God and Love your neighbour as yourself. For us Christians, our worship and our work are one and the same.

- ⇒ **April 7** - *Peace Giver - He knows our troubles*

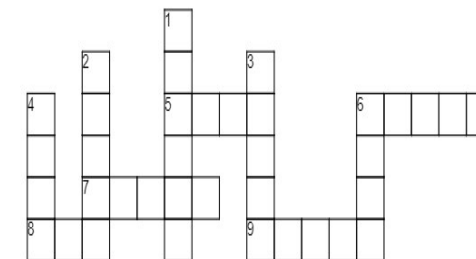
